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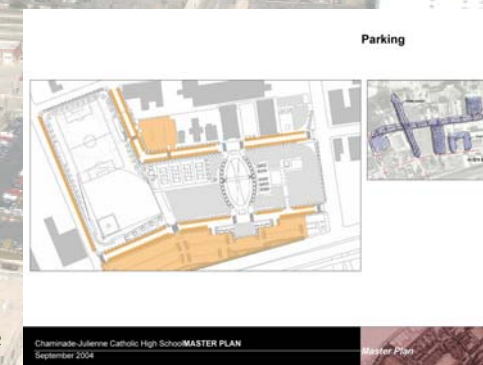

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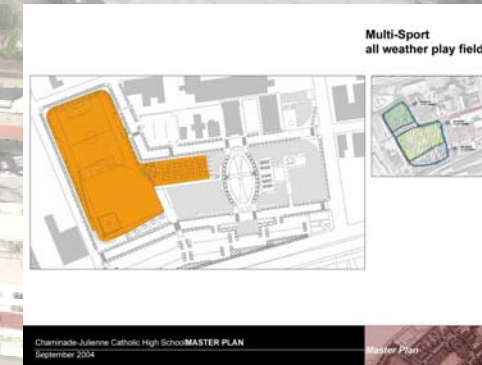
Chaminade-Julienne, located on the corner of Ludlow and Franklin Streets continuously since 1886, has been expanding its campus and plans to add facilities to better serve students from all over the region who value a high quality Catholic educational experience. The goal of the campus development project is to enhance existing buildings to meet the needs of a 21st century curriculum, add academic and athletic buildings to ensure outstanding learning opportunities in all their forms, and extend the campus boundaries to allow for student and alumni events on campus.

Since the plan, envisioned to be activated over 10 to 20 years, was developed in 2004, CJ has acquired four parcels of property and removed the shuttered buildings on those sites; worked with the City of Dayton to vacate surrounding streets; and developed 3.9 acres on Longworth Street into on-campus athletic practice space.



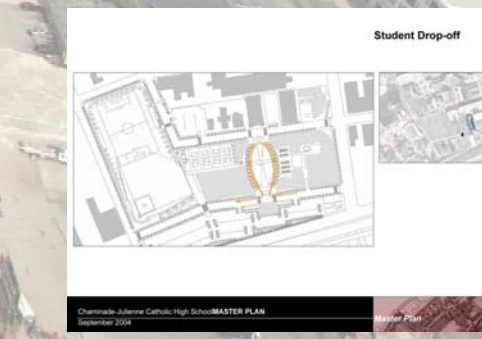
