CERTIFICATION

In order to participate in the Outdoor Market for *Art In The City*, you are **not** required to possess a vendors license. Original hand crafted items are preferred over mass produced. The Downtown Dayton Partnership will provide each vendor with one 6-foot table and one chair. Each vendor may bring a tent to utilize during the event, and must provide weights for the tent. Tents will be allowed *only* if the wind speed is forecasted for 10 miles per hour or less that evening. You will be notified the day of the event if tents will not be permitted. Set up may begin after 2 pm, and each vendor *must* stay between the hours of 5 and 9 pm. There will be a 50 vendor cap for the event. Please return completed form no later than July 20.
